	providing single phase 240 volt, 13 amps will be charged to all competitors.
	Competitors wishing to upgrade to 3 phase 380 volt/16amp have to request
	this on the entry form and will be charged an additional fee of Euro 150, If
	not requested in advance on the entry form an additional fee will be incurred
	at the event.

ENTRY FEE REFUND	Entry fees may only be refunded:

	c) in case a class is cancelled

	extinguisher is required, preferably powder. Failure to comply with this
	instruction could result in exclusion from the race event.
